## **CBI Opens with a Siena Win**

The seventh annual College Basketball Invitational began on Tuesday with Siena taking a 66-55 decision from Stony Brook.

The Saints (16-17) received a game-high 20 points from Rob Poole, who also had five rebounds and a pair of steals. Brett Bisping added 17 points, six rebounds, and two blocks.

Siena will host the winner of the Penn-State-Hampton game, which will be played on Wednesday.

Stony Brook (23-11) ended its season led by Jamal Warney and his 15 points and 10 rebounds. Anthony Jackson scored 13 points and Carson Puriefoy had 10 points.

The CBI continues on Wednesday with seven additional First Round games. In addition to Penn State-Hampton (7:00pm ET), South Dakota State is at Old Dominion (7:0pm ET), Texas A&M hosts Wyoming (8:00pm ET), Princeton travels to Tulane (8:00pm ET), Morehead State is at Illinois State (8:00pm ET), UTEP is home to Fresno State (9:00pm ET), and Oregon State hosts Radford (10pm ET).
