

Richmond Men's Basketball Beats Bryant To Advance In CBI

SMITHFIELD, R.I. – Junior guard Cedrick Lindsay scored a career-high 25 points to help lead the University of Richmond past Bryant University in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational on Wednesday night, 76-71.

With the victory, Richmond improves its record to 19-14 on the season and advances to second round of the CBI to play Wright State on Monday in Dayton, Ohio. With the loss, Bryant's season ends at 19-12.

Lindsay netted his career high of 25 points thanks to 8-of-12 shooting from the floor to go with four rebounds and four assists. Sophomore guard Kendall Anthony had 15 points off the bench for the Spiders, while senior Greg Robbins totaled 13 points and five boards. Senior Darien Brothers chipped in 10 points as well.

For the game, the Spiders shot 50 percent (26-of-52) from the floor, including 9-of-21 (42.9 percent) from beyond the arc. Led by Anthony, the Spider bench outscored Bryant's, 23-12, and Richmond scored 15 points off 14 Bryant turnovers.

The Richmond Spiders will travel to Dayton, Ohio to face Wright State in the second round of the CBI on Monday. Game time still to be announced.
