

San Francisco holds off Utah Valley to advance in CBI

SAN FRANCISCO - Jordan Ratinho and Chase Foster scored 20 points apiece and San Francisco withstood a furious Utah Valley rally to earn a 78-73 win.

The Dons led by 22 points, 64-42, with just 9:02 to play before Utah Valley stormed back, cutting the margin to three, 74-71, with 1:40 left in regulation. However, San Francisco survived the onslaught to advance to the CBI semifinals.

In addition to scoring 20 points, Foster also hauled down a team-best eight rebounds. Jimbo Lull joined his teammates in double figures with 15 points.

The Wolverines, who reached the CBI semis a year ago, were paced by the 26-point effort of Kenneth Ogbe. Brandon Randolph posted 22 points and seven rebounds and Akolda Manyang had 10 points and 11 rebounds.
